Summer Art Camp Instructor

The James Museum of Western & Wildlife Art is seeking a Visual Arts Instructor for its 2021 summer art camps. This is a 2-week, contracted position for the following weeks: July 12-16; July 26-30, 2021. The working hours are from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. Compensation is \$900/weekly.

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

- Provide engaging instruction to children ages 6 to 11.
- Lead all art sessions with age-appropriate lessons.
- Create a fun, playful and welcoming atmosphere.
- Assist in preparing lesson outlines and submit supply requests to Youth & Family Manager in a timely manner.
- Inventory studio supplies and compile requests for needed supplies.
- Supervise art studio/ classroom and lead assistant teen volunteers.
- Participate in studio set-up at the beginning of camp and clean up at the end.

- Experience teaching art to children in a K-5 classroom, museum or art studio.
- Knowledge of and experience with a variety of art materials and processes.
